Stephen Kelleher

Heads the Research and Development Department of Cambridge University Hospitals (CUH) and is responsible for the legal, financial and administrative aspects of the CUH's R&D activity. CUH has at any one time approximately 1000 research studies active at any one time and circa 200 studies in set up at any one time. CUH also acts as Sponsor to large portfolio of CTIMPS including multisite and multinational trials. Stephen is also the lead on IP exploitation and innovations for CUH and sits on a number of national strategy boards. Prior to his current role Stephen ran a number of research departments within the university sector both in the UK and abroad. Stephen also led on the FP6 implementation for the University of Cambridge and the FP7 implementation for University of Essex.

Nick Wareham

Nick Wareham is the Director of the MRC Epidemiology Unit and co-Director of the Institute of Metabolic Science. His principal research interests are the aetiology and prevention of obesity and diabetes. He also leads the Aetiology of Diabetes Programme.

Nick qualified from St Thomas' Hospital Medical School, London, and trained in epidemiology at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, London. He then worked at Harvard University, Boston, USA before joining the University of Cambridge where he became a Wellcome Trust Senior Fellow in Clinical Science. Now he is a Professor and an Honorary Consultant at Addenbrooke's Hospital, Cambridge. He is also the Clinical Lead for the Eastern England Diabetes Local Research Network.
